



DUE TO COVID-19, ONLY 175 PEOPLE* ARE ALLOWED IN THE CHURCH BUILDING AT ANY ONE TIME COMMENCING 25TH OCTOBER

*** from the Monday when NSW hits the 80% full vaccination target**

With the announcement of the easing of restrictions commencing Monday 25th October 2021, we are now limited by the 4 sqm rule indoor and 2 sqm rule outdoor. Hence, we are allowed to have 175 people in the church at any one time, excluding the clergy and those involved in the liturgy. There is no need to book.

The celebration of public Masses and all other religious services are now permitted.

The wearing of face masks indoors is MANDATORY. Children under 12 are exempt but are encouraged to wear masks where practicable.

CONTACT TRACING:

Because NSW Government still requires contact tracing, there are two ways to do this:

- Sign-in using the QR Code displayed in the foyer
- Mass Attendance cards MUST be completed by each household per mass. Cards are available in the foyer. Feel free to take home a few cards so you can complete them before going to church to avoid delay. Drop the completed card on the day you are attending in the designated box provided in the foyer

In order to maximise the use of our liturgical space, please observe the following:

- Families and those living under one household sit together.
- Proceed to end of row if vacant.
- Leave 3 chairs empty between you and another household.

Please be mindful of the following:

- ⇒ The 1.5 metre physical distancing rules will continue to apply whether indoors or outdoors.
- ⇒ Congregational singing is still NOT permitted. Choirs of up to 10 people can perform but all performers must be vaccinated.
- ⇒ Funerals permitted with up to 175 people (10-person limit for people who are not fully vaccinated).
- ⇒ Weddings ceremonies permitted with up to 175 people (5-person limit for people who are not fully vaccinated).
- ⇒ Outdoor public gathering permitted for up to 200 people.
