## LENT - 'When Lent finds us!'

Dear Friends,

One truth about Lent I have discovered over the years is that '*Lent finds us!*' In this context, we could also say that, '*The Cross finds us!*' During Lent, we need to examine how we deal with our current life circumstances - our attitudes, personal disposition, behaviour towards others, and outlook on world events and those in need.

In recent days, many people have been tested by the damage and flooding as a result of the cyclone Alfred in South East Queensland and Northern NSW. For some victims, this is a familiar and frightening experience. Indeed, the Cross and Lent have found them again and our hearts are moved by their plight.

Last week, I suggested the following prescription for a 'healthful' Lent – '*Pray carefully, give alms quietly, fast cheerfully!*' My intent was not to downplay our Lenten journey or avoid the reality around us but rather to invite each of us to reflect on our recent experiences, attend to our '*inner self*' and to adopt '*right thinking*' as we embrace this Season so that it becomes a labour of love rather than a heavy burden. Many are already burdened in the circumstances of their lives.

This Sunday's Gospel of the Transfiguration of Jesus may seem unusual in this context but it occurs in the setting of Jesus' prayer and actually foreshadows his eventual departure. Today's version taken from Luke belongs in this penitential season and brings balance to our diverse life experience.

Glory and reality meet in this event that lends itself readily to prayer and meditation. We are easily drawn into the experience of Jesus and the disciples and fully understand Peter's response, '*Lord, it is wonderful for us to be here; if you wish, I will make 3 tents here... for you, for Moses and for Elijah.*' When something good happens to us, we don't want it to stop, do we?

God's voice from the cloud confirms Jesus as his Son and Chosen One whom God will exalt in glory after his death. While our readings are about glory, God's promise and involvement in our lives, they are **not** about escaping from reality. The promise our faith offers is that we can live our faith while keeping our feet firmly fixed on the ground. We need to open our eyes and hearts to the small acts of love, gems that are part of each normal, mysterious day – these 'transfigurations' knit our lives together.

In his commentary Praying Luke, Fr John Reilly SJ suggests: '*With Peter and the others let the cloud envelop you, listen to the voice from the cloud and see Jesus alone*' – one way of helping our life, faith and prayer to connect.

## GOSPEL: Luke 9:28

Now about eight days after these sayings Jesus took with him Peter and John and James, and went up on the mountain to pray. And while he was praying, the appearance of his face changed, and his clothes became dazzling white. Suddenly they saw two men, Moses and Elijah, talking to him. They appeared in glory and were speaking of his departure, which he was about to accomplish at Jerusalem. Now Peter and his companions were weighed down with sleep; but since they had stayed awake, they saw his glory and the two men who stood with him. Just as they were leaving him, Peter said to Jesus, "Master, it is good for us to be here; let us make three dwellings, one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah" —not knowing what he said. While he was saying this, a cloud came and overshadowed them; and they were terrified as they entered the cloud. Then from the cloud came a voice that said, "This is my Son, my Chosen; listen to him!" When the voice had spoken, Jesus was found alone. And they kept silent and in those days told no one any of the things they had seen.

### Thought for the day

Stories of extraordinary experiences can leave us feeling on the outside— such moments of intense awareness of presence are rare and fleeting. And yet, we all have our inklings of something more, the surprise of God in the midst of the everyday. Any deep experience, when we take time to reflect on it and appropriate it, will disclose to us "the beyond in the midst" in Bonhoeffer's happy phrase. Love, birth, death, a child, nature, music, goodness and so on—all tokens of the something more which draws us on.

### Prayer

God of surprises, you are the beyond in the midst of life, always there to take us by surprise and delight us with your presence. Amen, amen!

## POINTERS FOR PRAYER

1. The transfiguration experience was one that affirmed Jesus' identity as the beloved disciple of God and strengthened him for the future. What have been the experiences, the moments of insight, that have clarified your sense of who you are and being beloved by God?
2. On the mountain the disciples saw Jesus in a new way. Sometimes in friendships there are moments of sharing in which we get to know a friend in a new and deeper way. Have you had that experience in human friendship, or in your relationship with Jesus, with God, or with the Spirit of God within? Recall when it happened and what it was like for you?
3. For the disciples, the experience also served as a reminder that their task as they accompanied Jesus on the road to Jerusalem was really to listen to him. This puts our Lenten efforts in context. What have you found helpful to get you to listen and to understand more deeply the meaning of the life and message of Jesus?

## PRAYER

God of the Covenant, your presence fills us with awe, your word gives us unshakable hope. Fix in our hearts the image of your Son in glory, that, sustained on the path of discipleship, we may pass over with him to newness of life. We make our prayer through Christ, our deliverance and hope, who lives and reigns for ever and ever. Amen.

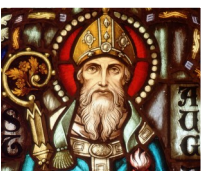

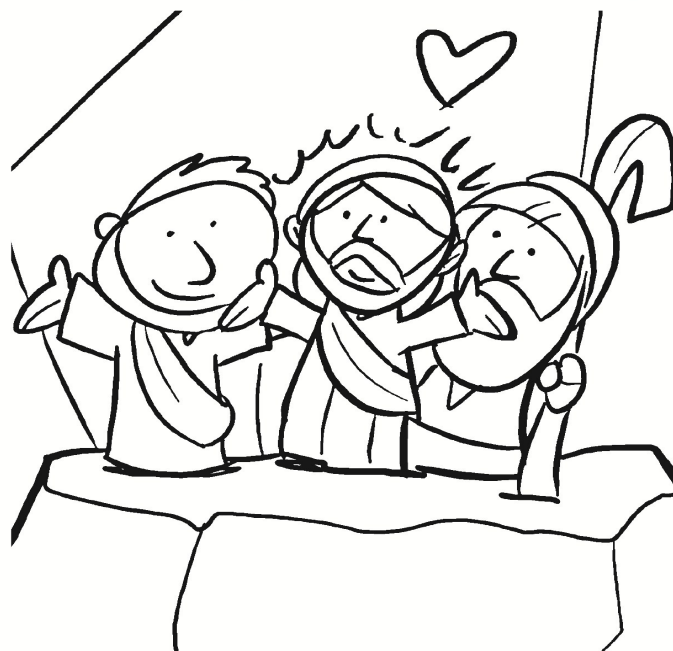
