## POPE LEO – Wisdom for the Family!

Dear Friends,

At the recent General Chapter of the Augustinians in Rome, Pope Leo was invited to preside at the Opening Mass of the Holy Spirit. He was preaching to his ‘family’ – the Augustinian Family – not an easy task as many of us know! Some of his insights may apply to our family too!

One thing I discovered at international meetings of Augustinians was not only the remarkable spirit of fraternity and hospitality common to all but also the strong cultural differences that colour how we see the Church and the world. For example, our Australian sense of humour and use of the ‘throw-away line’ are not always understood. Gatherings in Spain, Africa and Rome were clearly Augustinian but unique experiences of Church as well, especially in liturgy... Sunday Mass in Nigeria took close to 3 hours!!

The delegates at the General Chapter needed to get to know each other before voting for the Prior General and his Curia. Pope Leo reminded them that, together, they are ‘*members of the Body of Christ, who speaks all languages*’ and that God expects good to come out of that diversity as they discern together and *listen* – echoes of *synodality*!

Pope Leo counsels them to do all this with *humility* – ‘*Saint Augustine, commenting on the variety of ways in which the Holy Spirit has poured himself out onto the world throughout the centuries, reads this multiplicity as an invitation to us to make ourselves small in the face of the freedom and inscrutability of God’s action. Let no one think they have all the answers.*’

Each is to listen humbly to the Holy Spirit, appreciating God’s special presence and grace when we gather and allowing the Spirit to ‘teach’ and ‘remind’ us of what Jesus said (cf. *Jn 14:26*) - together seeking the common good in a spirit of *unity* - what unites is from God, but what divides cannot be. Each of us has received many gifts... just as ‘*we, though many, are one body, so it is with Christ*’ (1 Cor 12:12).

## Whoever is faithful in a very little is faithful also in much

### Gospel: Luke 16:1-13

1 Then Jesus said to the disciples, "There was a rich man who had a manager, and charges were brought to him that this man was squandering his property. 2 So he summoned him and said to him, 'What is this that I hear about you? Give me an accounting of your management, because you cannot be my manager any longer.' 3 Then the manager said to himself, 'What will I do, now that my master is taking the position away from me? I am not strong enough to dig, and I am ashamed to beg. 4 I have decided what to do so that, when I am dismissed as manager, people may welcome me into their homes.' 5 So, summoning his master's debtors one by one, he asked the first, 'How much do you owe my master?' 6 He answered, 'A hundred jugs of olive oil.' He said to him, 'Take your bill, sit down quickly, and make it fifty.' 7 Then he asked another, 'And how much do you owe?' He replied, 'A hundred containers of wheat.' He said to him, 'Take your bill and make it eighty.' 8 And his master commended the dishonest manager because he had acted shrewdly; for the children of this age are more shrewd in dealing with their own generation than are the children of light. 9 And I tell you, make friends for yourselves by means of dishonest wealth so that when it is gone, they may welcome you into the eternal homes. Luke 16:10 "Whoever is faithful in a very little is faithful also in much; and whoever is dishonest in a very little is dishonest also in much. 11 If then you have not been faithful with the dishonest wealth, who will entrust to you the true riches? 12 And if you have not been faithful with what belongs to another, who will give you what is your own? 13 No slave can serve two masters; for a slave will either hate the one and love the other, or be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and wealth."



## THOUGHT FOR THE DAY

The banking crisis is only one example of a wider "honesty deficit" in public life. Even people working for charities are sometimes found, unfortunately, to be lacking in integrity. As a result, the story of dishonest management will not lack contemporary echoes. It also means that the shock of story—the manager continues to fix the books for his own benefit—is just as much a shock today as it would have been in first-century Palestine. If that were not enough, the ironic teaching drawn in v. 9 borders on the sarcastic, not to say caustic. No missing the meaning, in any case! But what is the meaning? It can't be simply copy that distressing example of the manager. To act, not to delay, seems to be at the centre.

## POINTERS FOR PRAYER

1. As often with the parables of Jesus, this one is intended to shock in order to make us think. Jesus is not praising the injustice of the servant, but his purposefulness in preparing for the future. In your experience what difference does it make when you are purposeful and energetic instead of lethargic?
2. It was his master's call to account that galvanised the servant into action. What have been the experiences, or people, that have galvanised you into action when you had been somewhat halfhearted in your efforts?
3. Who have been the people whose energy, drive and astuteness have been an inspiration to you in how to handle difficult situations?

"No servant can be the slave of two masters". When have you experienced the truth of this statement?

## PRAYER

I truly believe and I know, God of our hearts, that you love and desire all that I am. May your great love penetrate even the darkest parts of my life that I may know true conversion of heart and love you with my whole self.
