## ASCENSION OF THE LORD - 'Letting Jesus go!'

Dear Friends,

I share a special quote from St Leo the Great, Pope from 440 to 461, on the Ascension:

*At Easter, beloved brethren, it was the Lord's resurrection which was the cause of our joy; our present rejoicing is on account of his ascension into heaven. With all due solemnity we are commemorating that day on which our poor human nature was carried up, in Christ, above all the hosts of heaven, above all the ranks of angels, beyond the highest heavenly powers to the very throne of God the Father...*

Leo goes on to describe how our Redeemer's visible presence has passed into the sacraments... and how, in a sense, Jesus is now 'more present in his divinity' to us.

No doubt the disciples missed Jesus, yet they met the challenge of spreading the Good News of Jesus' Resurrection among the people and our call to recognise the presence of Jesus in one another. Recall St Peter's words last Sunday: 'Reverence the Lord Christ in your hearts' – and the invitation in faith for us to *reverence the Lord Christ in the hearts of others too, as they do in us.*

In the first few centuries of the Church, celebration of the Ascension as a distinct feast was unknown. While the '40 days' has a broad theological significance, the actual dating of the Ascension 40 days after the Resurrection is found only in the Acts of the Apostles. Taking Jesus' own words, we believe that he returned to the Father but the time and manner remain a mystery. It is quite possible that the Ascension occurred on Easter Day. Eventually, the Church accepted the universal observance of the Ascension which in some countries is celebrated on Thursday and is a Holy Day of Obligation.

At present, we prepare to celebrate the Coming of the Holy Spirit, the Trinity, and the Body and Blood of Christ – great realities at the heart of our Faith. Just as the Ascension was an important moment of growth for the disciples, our losses impact us when loved ones die or depart for a lengthy period. We wonder how we will manage without the intimacy of their physical presence – but, hard as it is, somehow we eventually manage.

With Jesus, there is always something more, something new. When we 'let him go', his presence in our lives becomes even more profound – in our hearts, in our neighbour, in the Body of Christ, in his Word, in the Eucharist – gifts shared.

Recall the question of the two men in white to the apostles in Acts 1:10, 'Why are you men from Galilee standing here looking into the sky?' Jesus has returned to the Father but his living presence is here and now. What are we looking at? What do we see?

16 Now the eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain to which Jesus had directed them. 17 When they saw him, they worshiped him; but some doubted. 18 And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. 19 Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptising them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

### Thought for the Day

"We could ask how is the Risen Lord with us? The New Testament and the church tradition offer a rich array of "presences." Christ is present in the neighbour in need, in created reality beautiful and awe-inspiring, whenever the disciples gather, in the word proclaimed, in the sacrament celebrated and through the Holy Spirit. Perhaps we do not always feel this presence, but the words of Jesus are a guarantee that no matter what is going on in my life or my community or my church, he is with us, our Emmanuel.

### Pointers for Prayer

1. It is time for Jesus to return to his Father. He meets his disciples for the last time. His final words give them direction for their future. Perhaps you can recall such parting moments in your own life - leaving home, school, college, training, the death of a loved one. What was that like for you? Was there an occasion when words spoken then gave you direction for your future?

2. Perhaps you can identify with Jesus in the story, when, as a parent, teacher, or in some other way, you sent someone on his/her way in life, knowing you would not be with him or her as in the past. When did the way you parted help the other to make his or her own way in life?
3. Jesus told his disciples that although he would not be with them as he did in the past, he would be with them in a new way right through their lives. Have there been times when you were reassured by the love and support of another, even though s/he was not physically present with you?
4. In parting with his disciples, Jesus gave them a mission for the future. Where, when and how did you get a sense of the meaning and purpose of your own life? How does that sustain you now? Is there any way in which that purpose ties in with the mission given to the eleven to make disciples of all the nations?
5. Matthew's Gospel begins by introducing Jesus as "Emmanuel – God with us" and ends with the promise of Jesus to be with his disciples until the end of time. That promise is also to us. What are the things that help you to be aware of the presence of Jesus with you on life's journey?

### Prayer

Emmanuel—God with us—we thank you that you are indeed always with us. Help us to find you and recognise where you truly are, and not just where we want you to be. Amen.
