## SAFEGUARDING SUNDAY – ‘Love Protects!’

Dear Friends,

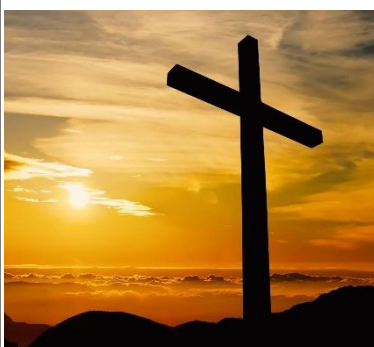
‘**Love Protects**’ is the theme of Safeguarding Sunday this year as we renew our commitment to children in our families, parish, Church and wider community. Children thrive when we play our part in keeping them safe and well. The increased emphasis on Safeguarding in recent years has made a big difference in the life of our children – in our ministry, in our work, in our families, in our neighbourhoods, and in our social groups.

Safeguarding applies to all and includes adults at risk as well. Abuse covers many areas of life – physical, sexual, psychological, spiritual, financial, to name but a few - and on occasion older people and the disabled who find themselves in a vulnerable position.

In the last year, our Parish has participated in both the Augustinian and Diocesan safeguarding audits and received a positive evaluation in both. Safeguarding is regularly on the agenda of the Parish Pastoral Council and meetings of the priests in the local deanery. Priests and Parish Team undergo regular training as do parishioners when required in their respective ministry roles. Under the guidance of Catholic Schools Parramatta, our Parish schools are constantly updating policies and practices.

As a Parish, we are constantly looking for opportunities to improve the safety of our environment and recently installed glass panels in office and meeting room doors to meet safeguarding requirements. Safeguarding policies of the Diocese and the Augustinians can be found on the internet, along with some information about the Parish. Not all will be aware that the main body of the church is locked during the school day to provide a secure environment for Holy Spirit Primary. The Blessed Sacrament Chapel is open for private prayer until 4.00 pm.

The Diocese of Parramatta reminds us that abuse can have long-term effects on many aspects of a person’s life, including health, relationships, wellbeing, faith, safety, and trust, and reaffirms its commitment to providing respectful, compassionate, and ongoing care that supports healing and recovery. The Diocese’s Healing and Support Team provides pastoral and therapeutic support to individuals who have experienced harm within a Church context, as well as those indirectly affected, such as family members.



This includes a respectful and welcoming space for people seeking support. Each person’s experience and needs are unique. There is no time limit on this service. You can reach out when you need help and stay connected for as long as you wish. Services include counselling and therapeutic support, pastoral and emotional support, practical guidance, resources, pathways and services, speaking to police, and spiritual support.

## 22<sup>nd</sup> SUNDAY in ORDINARY TIME, YR A

*I tell you that you forgive not seven times but seventy times seven.*

### Matthew 18:21-35

Peter went up to Jesus and said, 'Lord, how often must I forgive my brother if he wrongs me? As often as seven times?' Jesus answered, 'Not seven, I tell you, but seventy-seven times.'

'And so the kingdom of heaven may be compared to a king who decided to settle his accounts with his servants. When the reckoning began, they brought him a man who owed ten thousand talents; but he had no means of paying, so his master gave orders that he should be sold, together with his wife and children and all his possessions, to meet the debt. At this, the servant threw himself down at his master's feet. "Give me time," he said "and I will pay the whole sum." And the servant's master felt so sorry for him that he let him go and cancelled the debt. Now as this servant went out, he happened to meet a fellow servant who owed him one hundred denarii; and he seized him by the throat and began to throttle him. "Pay what you owe me", he said. His fellow servant fell at his feet and implored him, saying, "Give me time and I will pay you." But the other would not agree; on the contrary, he had him thrown into prison till he should pay the debt. His fellow servants were deeply distressed when they saw what had happened, and they went to their master and reported the whole affair to him. Then the master sent for him. "You wicked servant," he said. "I cancelled all that debt of yours when you appealed to me. Were you not bound, then, to have pity on your fellow servant just as I had pity on you?" And in his anger the master handed him over to the torturers till he should pay all his debt. And that is how my heavenly Father will deal with you unless you each forgive your brother from your heart.'

### FORGIVENESS - REFLECTION by Fr. Michael Tate

I don't like the phrase: 'Forgive and forget'. Remembering can be an important part of healing. Forgiving is about giving up the desire 'to get even', making sure that the 'punishment fits the crime'. It is that sort of forgiveness which we dare to ask of God for ourselves. But here's the catch: it is that sort of forgiveness which we must practise towards others.

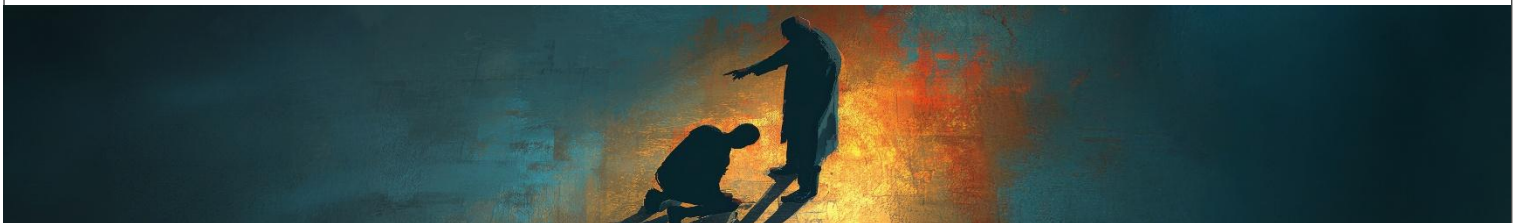
When we don't, we are like the principal debtor in Jesus' story. In harshly dealing with a minor debtor, he refused to share his king's quality of forgiveness. If we don't pass on this aspect of God's life to others, then we are warned that we will end up in a hellish situation unable to share in the fullness of Divine life.

It is easy to talk 'Big Picture' forgiveness. It is much harder within the family or circle of acquaintances. It seems impossible to simply will it. But we have to ask for the grace to do it.

We could pause for a moment to pray:

'Our Father who art in Heaven . . . forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us.'
